Impact

Since our first post in July of 2012 we have posted bi-monthly on topics that typically fall into one of three categories: personal stories, scientific explanations, or travel.

Our site has been viewed in over 95 countries with over 14,000 total views. We get over 500 unique visitors every month.

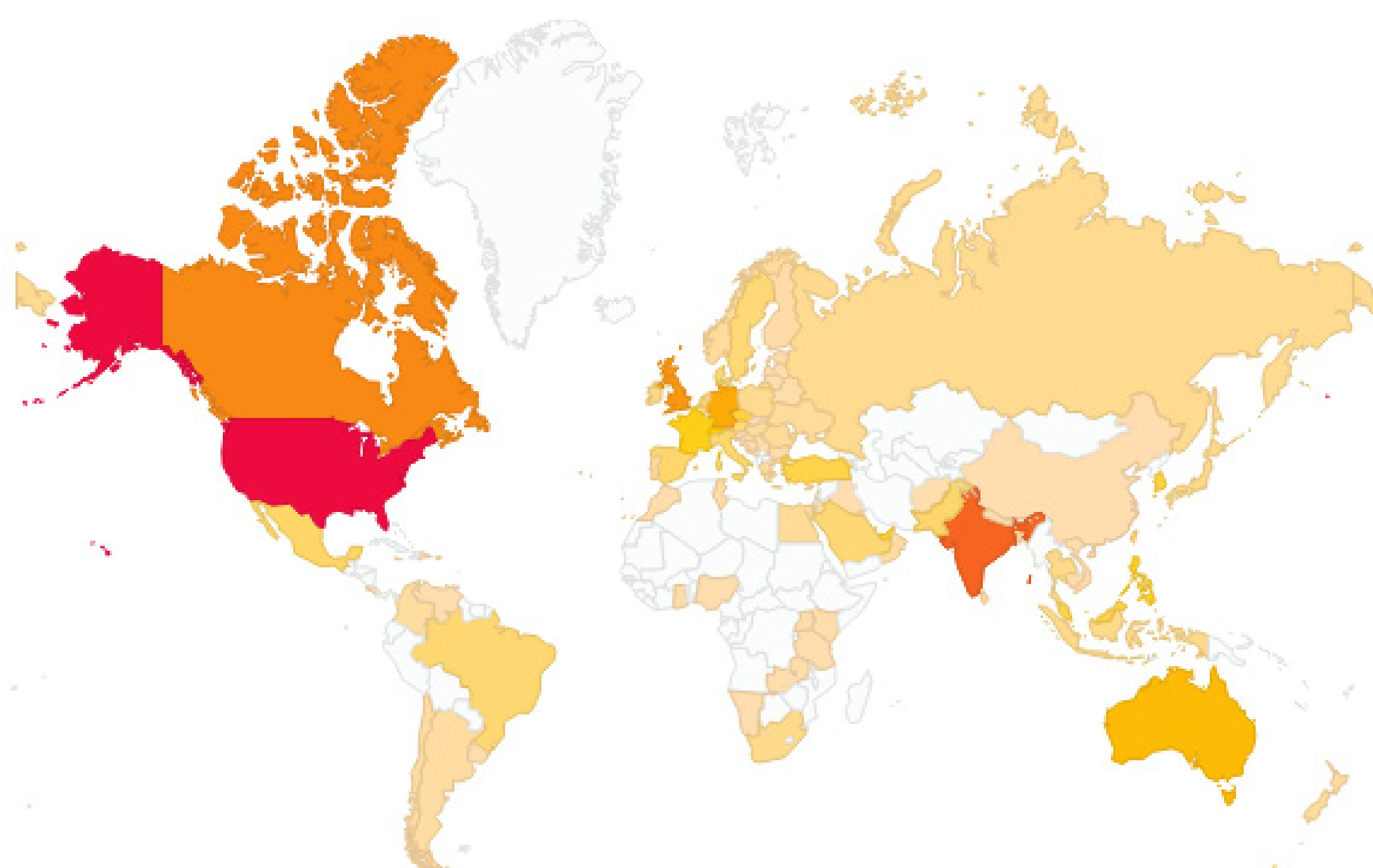
