

Teen Leadership 20

Purpose

In 4-H the opportunity to facilitate a leadership development activity is frequent, but the experience of the facilitator varies. The Ohio 4-H Teen Leadership Design Team developed Teen Leadership 20 as a tool for any facilitator.

The double-blind peer-reviewed Teen Leadership 20 curriculum can be used by facilitators to teach one leadership lesson in a 20-minute time frame. The 20 lessons are designed to allow opportunities for teen participants to develop leadership skills through multiple topics.

Impact
